

BIOGRAPHY

Born in Heilingenstadt in Thüringen, East Germany in 1947. When he was five, his family escaped from East Germany to West Berlin. Uli Gassmann's earliest playgrounds were bombed out buildings, vestiges of World War II. Gassmann grew up at his parents' truck and heavy equipment dealership. Before he began his career as an artist, he was a car engineer.

Today, he works as an architect, stage designer, photographer, sculptor and painter, in various locations around the world, including a wooded property outside of San Francisco, a former military bunker on the Maginot Line in Eastern France, and at one time the only private property in Berlin with a still standing chunk of the Wall.

After Yves Saint Laurent's death, Uli Gassmann asked Pierre Bergé if he could document the couturier's Avenue Marceau studio and the couple's apartment at 55 rue de Babylone in Paris, which led to a series of drawings.

Uli Gassmann was also an artist in residence at the Jardin Majorelle. He drew and painted the private garden of the Villa Oasis, Villa Dar Es Saada, the Jardin Majorelle and the Pierre Bergé Museum of Berber Arts. This exhibition in the theater lobby at the musée Yves Saint Laurent Marrakech is the result of his work in Paris and Marrakech.
